Introduction



- By virtue of a Trilateral Agreement for the Sharing, Transfer, Repatriation, Disposition and Management of Certain Forfeited Assets (Trilateral Agreement) by and among the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the Bailiwick of Jersey and the Government of the United States of America (together, the Competent Authorities) dated the 3rd of February 2021, the sum of USD 311.8 million (Recovered Assets) was transferred to the Nigeria Sovereign Investment Authority (NSIA or the Authority) as Implementing Authority of the Federal Republic of Nigeria under the Agreement. Furthermore, additional recovered assets, EUR5,343,105.95; GBP4,214,017.66; GBP210,610.00; and USD20,637,622.00 have also been transferred to the NSIA for application to the three projects.
- This report is provided in fulfilment of obligation of the NSIA to provide quarterly reports to the Competent Authorities under the Trilateral Agreement.

- Mecosta Recovered Funds amounted to US\$20,637,622 (Twenty Million, Six Hundred and Thirty-seven Thousand, Six Hundred and Twenty-two US Dollars) was received by the NSIA in December 2023 and applied to the three PIDF projects.
- Additional forfeited funds following a Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Federal Republic of Nigeria were received as follows: (Euro 5,343,105.95 and GBP 4,214,017.66)
- The sum of £210,610.00 being compensation amount derived from the Deferred Prosecution Agreement between the Serious Fraud Office and AMEC Foster Wheeler Energy Limited has been received and applied to the 3 projects.
- Treasury management activities undertaken by NSIA in the quarter yielded interest in the sum of N450,938,608.16.



Disbursements in the total sum of N22,795,772,066.52 were made from the Recovered Assets
