Summary of Ongoing Projects



- On 25th February 2018, His Excellency President Muhammadu Buhari (GCFR) approved the establishment of the Presidential Infrastructure Development Fund ("PIDF") to accelerate the execution of strategic infrastructure projects essential to the rapid growth and modernization of Nigeria's economy.
- The Nigeria Sovereign Investment Authority ("NSIA") is currently acting as the Fund Manager for PIDF and is responsible for overseeing the development of the Ongoing Projects which include (i) Lagos-Ibadan Expressway ("LIE"), (ii) Second Niger Bridge Project ("2NB"), and (iii) Abuja-Kaduna-Zaria-Kano Road ("AKR").
- It is expected that 2NB will be commissioned before the current administration leaves office, at a date to be determined by the Presidency. LIE is expected to be completed in 2023 and AKR in 2025 as a result of the 11 months halt due to force majeure following the Abuja – Kaduna bound train attacks
- The Ongoing Projects will be commercialized through tolling, concessions, marketing and other revenue generating strategies, with LIE forecasted to be the most lucrative due to its heavy traffic count and location.
- Dar Al-Handasah Consultants Limited in consortium with TSL Engineering Limited ("Dar and TSL") has been engaged as the Technical Adviser ("TA") on 2NB as well as LIE. Similarly, Ondur Engineering Limited & Hancock Ogundiya & Partners Limited has been engaged as TA on AKR.
- To date, the NSIA has received recovered funds totalling US\$342.8 million which include the US\$311.8 million recovered from the Abacha family, US\$10.4 million recovered from UK and Ireland and \$20.6 million Mecosta funds. The recovered funds are used for disbursements towards works done on the PIDF projects. Full details of all recovered funds can be found in the financial update section.

Overview

- The Lagos-Ibadan Expressway ("LIE") is a 127.6 km-long expressway widely regarded as the busiest interstate in the country and the major connection route between the northern, southern and eastern parts of Nigeria.
- The project is being executed in two sections; Section I (Lagos-Shagamu) is constructed by Julius Berger Nigeria Plc ("JBN"), while Section II (Shagamu-Ibadan) is by Reynolds Construction Company ("RCC")

Current Status


- Section 1 94% of LIE Section 1 which is being handled by JBN has been completed to date and ₩12.2 bn has been disbursed to JBN from the recovered funds for works done on this project.
- Section 2 92% of LIE Section 2 which is being handled by RCC has been completed to date and ₩25.3 bn has been disbursed to RCC from the recovered funds for works done on this project.
- The Federal Executive Council ("FEC") has approved the Augmentation proposal of ₩22.1bn to the LIE section II contract, required to complete the main carriageway (Phase I) due to shortfall of items on permanent works and Variation of Price ("VOP").

Overview

- The Second Niger Bridge project involves the construction of a 1.6km bridge across the River Niger, with two separate superstructures and 10.3km roads, linking Anambra and Delta States, in the southeast of the country.
- The project is being executed by JBN.

Current Status

- 98% of 2NB has been completed to date. ₩42.8 bn has been disbursed to JBN from the recovered funds for works done on this project.
- The FEC has approved the Construction of 2.4km Link Road linking the Asaba end of 2NB to the Approach Road of Phase 2A.
- The construction of the Link Road will lead to the early commissioning of the bridge and have the bridge operational and generating revenue through the collection of toll fees.
- The PIDF team has also been informed of FEC's approval of the \(\mathbb{H}\)4.5bn Augmentation proposal on 2NB, to provide for additional VOP provision, due to shortfall of items on permanent works.
- There is indication that the 2NB main bridge will be commissioned before the current administration leaves office.



Overview

- The Abuja–Kaduna–Kano road original project involves the rehabilitation, expansion and construction of 92.5km (25%) of the 375.9km dual carriageway.
- The scope of the project changed from a rehabilitation to the full reconstruction of 375.9km as directed by Mr. President in June 2020, with total project cost at ₩655.2bn
- The project is being executed by JBN.

Current Status

- 100% Revised BEME (REBEME2) and 48% Augmentation BEME (ABEME) of the AKR scope has been completed to date and \(\mathbb{\text{\text{4}}}\)46.5 bn has been disbursed to JBN from recovered funds for works done on this project.
- During the PIDF Steering Committee ("SteerCo") that held on April 3, 2023, JBN informed the SteerCo that sections II (Kaduna Zaria) and III (Zaria Kano) of AKR will attain substantial completion by May 15, 2023.
- There is possibility that section II would be commissioned before the present administration leaves office.

The Abacha funds were converted at an exchange rate of \\$360/\\$1 amounting to \\$112.2 billion. \\$23.6 billion was gained from interest accrued on investment activities, making the total Abacha funds to be \\$135.9 billion. Consequently, the allocation per project has increased with \\$44.7 billion being allocated to each project and \\$1.7 billion budgeted as contingency balance. Payments to consultants are made from the contingency budget.

2. Summary of IC 48 (October 2022)

The Interim Certificate No. 48 covered the works executed by the contractor as at the end of October 2022. The Interim Certificate was vetted by the Federal Ministry of Works and Housing and further checked by the Technical Advisers (Ondur/HOP).

The works were carried out satisfactorily and in conformity with the relevant clauses of the FMW&H specifications and standard conditions of Contracts.

The certified amount of the permanent works are consistent with the works executed on site as shown in the summary of works done during the month.

The amount certified for payment by FMW&H is ₹3,790,457,564.85 while the sum of ₹4,385,926,546.59 was recommended by Ondur/HOP.

The difference in the FMW&H certified amount and that of Ondur/HOP is due to the restoration of claims in Section II that were earlier declined in IC 44, IC 46 and IC 47. The restoration is allowed because provision is now made for the quantities and funding of these items of work in the approved RBEME No.3. The total amount restored is in the sum of \$\frac{14}{3}\$ 553,924,634.18. This is made up of \$\frac{14}{3}\$ 153,124,243.63, \$\frac{14}{3}\$ 269,813,963.54, and \$\frac{14}{3}\$ 130,986,427.01 in IC 44, IC 46, and IC 47 respectively
